

John Davidson School Re-Entry Plan – September 2021

Current learning scenarios:

- We are currently providing Scenario 1 within the Alberta government's 2021-22 education criteria: In-school learning.
- John Davidson School will follow all provincial and Palliser protocols and guidelines.

What will we do at John Davidson School to keep students & staff safe:

- Continue with quality, AHS suggested cleaning protocols.
- Continue with hand sanitation on entry of the building and class areas.
- Continue screening for illness and specific COVID-19 symptoms as outlined by AHS (details in Palliser / province's re-entry plan).
- If students or staff are sick or have symptoms then they won't attend, or if symptoms develop at school, they will be isolated and sent home. Visitors are asked to not enter the building with symptoms.
- Measures are subject to change at the discretion / direction of AHS and/or Palliser. If this occurs, parents will be notified accordingly.
- Masks must be worn for all types of transportation (on school buses), 100% of the trip as per current provincial guidelines.
- Visitors must schedule their visit with their child's teacher, principal, administrative assistant, sign in, sanitize.
- No assemblies or large gatherings indoors (outside events may take place).
- Staff and students may wear masks (optional) in common spaces if they so choose (e.g. hallways, classrooms, Learning Commons).
- **All individuals' personal choices related to masks and COVID will be respected.**
